COVID-19 Safety Guidelines for Fall Semester 2020

We are committed to presenting arts education in the safest way possible. Along with state guidelines, these are the steps we are taking to ensure safety during this unprecedented time.

All students, instructors, parents, and other persons entering the building must wear a mask **and continue wearing it** unless instructed by a Ghostlight Academy instructor.

We ask everyone in the building to maintain proper social distance (six feet) as much as possible while inside. Lobby area is limited, so parents/guardians are asked to wait outside for dropping off and picking up students unless prior arrangements have been made with the instructor.

Proper cleaning practices are being taken very seriously to ensure all rooms are sanitized between each class. We ask that you do your part in sanitizing and washing your hands frequently when entering and exiting the building.

Changing room space is limited, so students should come dressed and ready for class. Each student and instructor will have a no-touch temperature check before class begins. Anyone presenting with a temperature $> 100.4^{\circ}$ will be asked to leave and should consult with a physician for further evaluation.

Please do not come to class if you or someone you live with have any of the following symptoms: cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, unusual headache, unexplained muscle and or joint pain, chills, fever, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, unusual congestion, loss of sense of smell, pink eye, or signs of increased fatigue.
